

Update International Training Organization Constellations 2010

At this moment we have about sixteen participants from 8 different countries, so this training promises to become a real international event.

Level of experience in constellation work

It is also clear that you come with a wide range of experience in constellation work, some of you having finished a training already. Don't worry: we will make sure this training will meet the most advanced standards in constellation work in organizations that we can deliver to you and co-create with you at the moment. But of course also participants with less experience are welcome in a way that everybody can learn according to your level of interest and experience.

International Forum

Many of you have indicated that you want to meet colleagues, to have each other and the training as a kind of international forum where all your questions about the introduction of systemic work or how to work with constellations in firms, may find well willing ears and trigger a lot of common experience and creative ideas and approaches.

Practising.

We do suppose that you will have your own possibilities to practise in your own country. Nevertheless, since it will be not so easy to form international practise groups (it would be fun though, I myself participate in one international intervision group, meeting once a year in the Dolomites, combining intervision and skiing), we offer you the possibility to practise one day after and/or before each module.

This implies that the training centre is completely yours, you self-organize how and what you want to practise. Anton de Kroon will be available during those days as a host.

For Module 1 we offer: Wednesday March 24 as practise day

For Module 2 we offer: Thursday June 24 and Wednesday June 30 (so one day before and one day after the module).

For Module 3 we offer: Tuesday November 9 (remember: Wednesday November 10 is reserved for personal work)

Of course this only makes sense when sufficient participants are interested to take part in these practise options. And since this would influence your travel schedule, *please let us know as soon as you can if*

you aim to participate in these practise days (and which ones). To be clear: these practise days are free of extra costs, other then paying one more night for your own hotel or B&B.

We are looking very much forward to meet and work together in this international training event.
